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The role of different tools in distance/online learning

Used in contact meetings and distance periods

Shared digital platform, "home base"

(e.g. Google Classroom, Moodle)

- timetables, instructions
- links to teaching and study materials
- links to other applications
- submission folders or links to students' outcomes
- assessment procedures

Used in online contact meetings

Online meeting tool

(e.g. Zoom, Teams meetings)

- participant coordination
- sharing screens, presentations or files
- communication (voice and video, chat, reactions)
- collaboration (notes, whiteboard)
- small group spaces



Used in contact meetings and distance periods

Other web-based tools and cloud services

(e.g. Google apps, Padlet, Kahoot)

- motivation, activation, brainstorming
- practicing, knowledge production
- sharing, interaction, co-authoring, publishing



To be chosen by teachers based on preferences and pedagogical goals











Applications available for multiple purposes

Top 100 Tools for Learning - Categories

Note: Most of the tools on the list are general tools, not specifically intended for teaching/learning purposes

- 1. Office tools & suites (Document, Presentation, Spreadsheet, File sharing, Email, Digital notebooks)
- 2. **Content development** (Screenshots, Screencasts, Graphics, Audio, Animation, Video, Live video streaming, Interactive content, Forms and surveys, Blogs and websites)
- 3. Learning tools & platforms (Authoring, Edu learning platforms, Edu content, Edu quizzes/tests, Corporate learning platforms, Online course platforms, Language learning apps)
- 4. Social & collaboration platforms (Video meeting, Team collaboration, Messaging app, Live engagement, Online whiteboards, Other collaboration tools, Social networks)
- 5. **Web tools & platforms** (Browsers, Web search, Reference, Online translators, E-books and audio books, Book summaries, Podcasts/players, Video and films, Presentations, RSS/news readers, Alerts, Curation, Miscellaneous)
